PROMOTION POLICY (III to VIII)

School will assess a child in Scholastic and Co-Scholastic areas. Scholastic areas will include Internal / Periodic Assessment (20 marks) and External Assessment (80 marks).

- Internal Assessment for each term will comprise Pen Paper Test (5 marks) + Multiple Assessment (5 marks) + Portfolio (5 marks) + Subject Enrichment Activity (5 marks).
- There will be Periodic Test in First Term (April to October) & Second Term (November to March) along with Half-Yearly Examination (in October). Annual Examination will be in March 2024.
- The syllabus for Periodic Test will be the chapters that are taught in the class one week before the Test.
- The syllabus for Half Yearly will be approximately 50% of the Curriculum i.e., Term 1 Syllabus.
- The syllabus for Annual Examination in classes VI to VIII will be the <u>entire</u> <u>syllabus of Term-II + few important topics of Term-I.</u>
- Co-scholastic Areas include Art Education, Health & Physical Education along with Discipline.
- Child needs to secure 33% in Half Yearly and Annual Examination separately (i.e., 26.5 out of 80) to pass in a particular subject. <u>To get passed and</u> <u>promoted to next class, child has to secure 33% in each subject.</u>
- If a child secures E-grade (below 33 %) in Half Yearly and Annual Examination in a particular subject, then he/she can be given one <u>opportunity to IMPROVE</u> <u>his/her performance</u> in Half Yearly & Annual Exam separately based on the syllabus meant for Term-I & Term-II respectively.
- The syllabus for Annual Examination in <u>class VI</u> will be <u>10% of Term-I</u> <u>covering significant topics + Entire syllabus of Term-II.</u>
- The syllabus for Annual Examination in <u>class VII</u> will be <u>20% of Term-I</u> <u>covering significant topics + Entire syllabus of Term-II.</u>
- The syllabus for Annual Examination in <u>class VIII</u> will be <u>30% of Term-I</u> <u>covering significant topics + Entire syllabus of Term-II.</u>
- 75% Attendance is a must for a child to appear for Term-II Examination held in March 2023. In case a child is falling short of the mandatory 75%, then he/she will not be eligible to appear in Annual Examination. Please ensure that your child fulfils attendance criteria.

PROMOTION POLICY (IX & X)

School will assess a child in Scholastic and Co-Scholastic areas. Scholastic areas will include Internal / Periodic Assessment (20 marks) and External Assessment (80 marks).

- Internal Assessment will comprise Pen Paper Test (5 marks) + Multiple Assessment (5 marks) + Portfolio (5 marks) + Subject Enrichment Activity (5 marks).
- There will be one cycle of Periodic Test in First Term (April to October) & Second Term (November to March) along with Half-Yearly Examination (in October).
- The syllabus for Periodic Test will be the chapters that are taught in the class one week before the Test.
- The Annual Examination will comprise of the syllabus as prescribed by CBSE.
- Child needs to secure 33% in Periodic/ Internal Assessment and 33% in Term-I and Term-II Exam each (i.e., 26.5 out of 80) to pass in a particular subject. If a child fails to secure the same, he/she is eligible for the Compartment Exam. To get passed and promoted to the next class, a child has to secure 33% in each subject.
- Child is eligible for the Compartment Exam in only TWO subjects. A child having failed in three or more subjects, is DETAINED. Compartment Exam will comprise of the entire syllabus of a particular subject and will be tentatively in the month of June /July (as per CBSE norms). There is only ONE ATTEMPT for qualifying the Compartment Exam. Students will be detained if they fail to pass the Compartment Exam. There won't be any Second Compartment Exam under any circumstances and reasons (medical or otherwise).
- 75% Attendance is a must for a child to appear for Annual Examination held in March 2024. In case a child is falling short of the mandatory 75%, then he/she will not be eligible to appear in Annual Examination. Please ensure that your child fulfills attendance criteria.
- Co-Scholastic Areas include Art Education, Health & Physical Education along with Discipline.
